

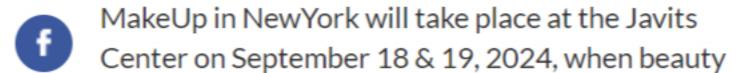
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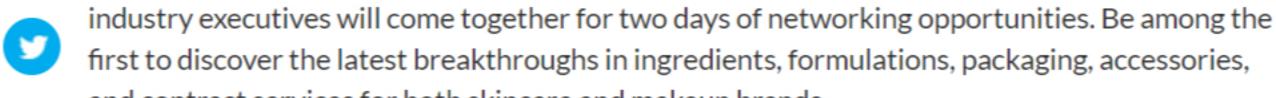
MakeUp in NewYork to Welcome Visitors on September 18th

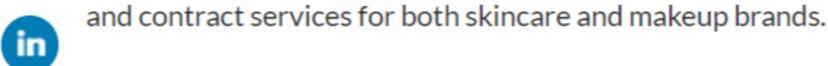
Danessa Myricks, Founder & CEO, Danessa Myricks Beauty, will give the keynote, 'Limitless Beauty.'

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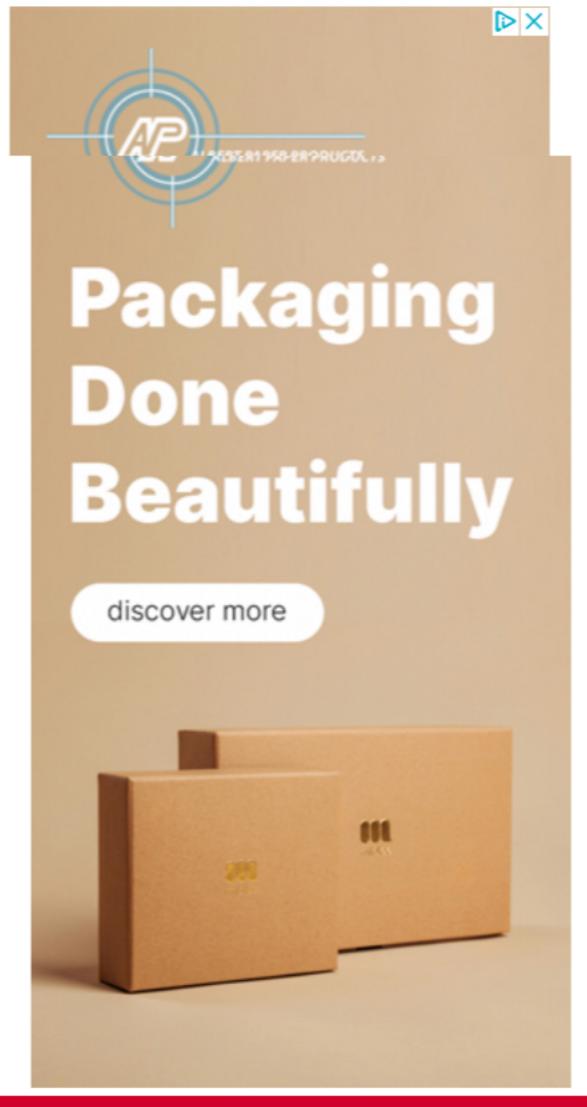
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
